**Please read the following carefully:**

JCAS determines the criteria for fostering, decides which animals are eligible for foster care, and appoints foster caregivers from an approved list of trained providers. JCAS foster care volunteers may always refuse any specific request for any reason and JCAS has the right to have the foster pet returned to the shelter at this point. JCAS staff will inform you of any medical treatments to be administered, the anticipated length of the foster-care period, the objectives of each placement (restoring to health, rearing to adoptable age, socialization, etc.), and any other restrictions or expectations we may have.

It is the responsibility of the foster care giver to keep the animal safe and secure, return it to JCAS when requested to do so, and NOT promise the animal to anyone or imply that you have the authority to approve a potential adoption.

JCAS retains ownership of all animals placed in foster care and will make all decisions regarding the adoption and placement of the animals fostered.

The foster parent is responsible for transporting the animals to and from scheduled veterinary appointments, surgery, behavior evaluations, vaccinations, etc. The foster caretaker may also be responsible for transporting the animal to and from adoption events, and to off-site training classes, at the Foster Care Coordinator's discretion. Upon return of your foster animal to JCAS you will be required to advise staff of the animal's behavior and personality.

**Rules for fostering:**

- JCAS foster caretakers will solely foster for our agency. We ask that there be no other fosters from other agencies during the time they have active fosters from our shelter.
- Any medical advice, care advice, etc. must come from JCAS staff and/or our approved licensed Veterinarians **ONLY!**
- Non-emergency messages are to be sent during business hours only. For emergency situations you can utilize the number listed below to reach staff. **785-530-9947 (Vanessa Gray)**.
- Foster caretakers are allowed to advertise animals they are caring for after sending a rough draft to the Director to review to ensure all information is accurate.
- All kittens and puppies should have 24/7 access to both food and water. Kittens and puppies 6 weeks of age and younger must have 24/7 access to wet food and milk replacer unless directed otherwise.
- Contact to shelter employees should be made through the JCAS Facebook messenger, BAND APP or the emergency phone number listed above. Please do not contact shelter staff on personal Facebook pages.
- Foster animals cannot leave the area or be cared for by others unless prior authorization from JCAS.
- Fosters **CANNOT** go to the dog park or be introduced to other animals during foster without prior authorization from JCAS.
- Fosters will abide by all regulations and rules appointed by shelter staff, City of Junction City Ordinances, and State of Kansas Regulations

I have read and understand the statements above. I certify that all the information contained in this application is true and correct. I understand that although JCAS takes reasonable care to screen animals for foster placement, it makes no guarantees relating to the animal's health, behavior, or actions. I understand that I receive foster care animals at my own risk and can decline to accept any animal for which JC/GCAS has asked me to provide care. I acknowledge that JCAS is not responsible for any property damage, personal injury suffered by me, members of my household, including my own animals, or any third parties during a foster placement, and I assume liability to provide adequate controls to prevent damage or injury. Failure to comply with these rules will result in your foster pet being returned and losing your foster care privileges.
