

**RESOLUTION R-3123**

**A RESOLUTION NOTING AND PURSUING THE BEAUTIFUICATION AND MAINTENANCE OF GRANT AVENUE AND ADJACENT PROPERTIES BY THE CITY OF JUNCTION CITY AND ITS INHABITANTS & TAXPAYERS FOR THE CITY OF JUNCTION CITY, KANSAS**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Junction City, Kansas desires to improve, beautify, maintain, and sustain its infrastructure, parks, properties, and other assets of the City of Junction City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City understands that it is coming out of a time of deferred maintenance to its assets due to financial debt that exceeded where said debt should have been; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to grow and fortify itself by improving and maintaining its infrastructure, appearance, and other assets by funneling money, efforts, energy, and personnel to do so; and

**WHEREAS**, the City understands it must do so within the confines of its budget and legal authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has a main entrance into and thoroughfare through Junction City along Grant Avenue, which is also a pathway to Fort Riley; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Junction City implores and desires the same from its citizens, taxpayers, and customers as the City seeks to be both role model and code enforcer.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF JUNCTION CITY, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **RESOLVED**, that the City Commission of the City of Junction City seeks that the City staff shall endeavor to improve and maintain City infrastructure, beautification, and other appropriate measures along and around Grant Avenue within legal, financial, and ethical means.
2. **RESOLVED**, that the City Commission implores residential, commercial, industrial, public, nonprofit, and other landowners to beautify, improve, maintain, clean-up, et cetera their lands at, adjacent to, or nearby Grant Avenue in addition to making the same request of tenants and lessees of the same lands.
