

RESOLUTION NO. R-3127

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF JUNCTION CITY, KANSAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE NECESSARY STEPS TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, BETTER UTILIZING INVESTMENTS TO LEVERAGE DEVELOPMENT (BUILD) GRANT PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT ON THE CITY'S BEHALF TO ADMINISTER THE GRANT, AND PLEDGING THAT THE CITY OF JUNCTION CITY, KANSAS, WILL COMPLY WITH THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS OF THE BUILD GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Junction City, Kansas, is seeking funding from the United States Department of Transportation, Better Utilizing Investment to Leverage Development (BUILD) Program with the support of the Kansas Congressional Delegation and Fort Riley Military Installation for the Grant Avenue Road Project; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation, through the BUILD program, advances the priorities of the City of Junction City by providing targeted support that enhances public safety, promotes sustainable infrastructure improvements, and fosters the continued economic and community development of the incorporated city; and

WHEREAS, the City of Junction City is qualified to apply for grant funds under BUILD.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JUNCTION CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1. The City Manager and City Staff is designated as the authorized official for the grant and given power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant and such funding awarded by the Department of Transportation. Grant funds will be used to repair Grant Avenue and attenuating concerns (stormwater drainage, et cetera that derive from this roadway) in support of Fort Riley, private industry, and community residents.

Section 2. If awarded, the City commits, under Kansas Budget and Cash-Basis Law as well as the City's Fiscal Policy, to allocate monies to cover all cost overruns that may exceed the current estimated cost for the project.

Section 3. The City Manager and City Staff will act on behalf of the City of Junction City, Kansas, in all matters related to the grant application and any

subsequent grant contract and grant project that may result. The City Manager and City Staff will act on the City's behalf in administering the BUILD grant.

Section 4. That the City of Junction City will comply with the grant requirements of the BUILD grant.

Section 5. That grant funds will be used only for the purpose for which they are intended under the BUILD Grant Program.

Section 6. That the City of Junction City, in the event of loss or misuse of the BUILD funds, assures that the funds will be returned to the Department of Transportation in full.
