

ORDINANCE NO. G-1122

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE II. PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF JUNCTION CITY, KANSAS BY AMENDING CHAPTER 220 OFFENSES; ARTICLE IV: OFFENSES AGAINST PROPERTY; SECTION 220.460.

WHEREAS, Junction City has recognized the need to modify the current Unlawful Damage to Property ordinance so that it most accurately reflects and follows the current guidelines for misdemeanor prosecution of unlawful damage to property.

WHEREAS, Junction City has recognized the need to be able to prosecute misdemeanor cases, where damage exceeds \$500.00 but is still less than \$1000.00.

WHEREAS, Junction City has recognized the need in uniform enforcement of its laws within the state guidelines.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF JUNCTION CITY, KANSAS:


SECTION 220.460 is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 220.460

- A. Unlawful damage to property is by means other than by fire or explosive:
1. Willfully injuring, damaging, mutilating, defacing, destroying, or substantially impairing the use of any property in which another has an interest without the consent of such other person; or
 2. Injuring, damaging, mutilating, defacing, destroying, or substantially impairing the use of any property with intent to injure or defraud an insurer or lienholder.
- B. Unlawful damage to property is a Class A misdemeanor if the property damaged is of the value of less than one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) or is of a value of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) or more and is damaged to the extent of less than one thousand dollars (\$1000.00).

This ordinance shall become effective upon publication in the Junction City Daily Union as required by law.
