Re: Leaf Collection Drop off Program

The City of Junction City is please to announce a fall leaf collection drop off program. Starting Monday, November 5th and continuing as weather permits through the end of November, Junction City residents may bring bags of leaves, grass clippings and bulk leaves to be dropped off at one of three following locations listed below.

Residents are asked to only drop off leafs or grass clippings---NO TRASH ALLOWED. The drop off centers will be on the honor system relying on the public to not place trash in the collection bin areas. The drop-off center bins will be constructed of concrete barriers and signed accordingly at each of the three locations.

If trash and other non bio-degradable materials become an issue the drop off collection system will stop and the program will be restructured.

Leaf Drop-off Locations:

Playground Park	West 5 th St.
North Park	Thompson Drive
Public Works Center	2324 N. Jackson

The intent of the program is to allow residences an opportunity to drop and remove leafs and other bio-degradable materials to be removed from the landfills and sanitation and further help in maintaining affordable sanitation rates within our community. Thus please look to do your part in cleaning up and maintaining our City.
